

## RD Client for access to Epitaph and AdvantEDGE

Since migrating our service over to RemoteApps, we can now offer a quick and easy to setup, simple platform for being able to connect onto either Epitaph or AdvantEDGE, from your Apple or Android,

smartphone, tablet or Apple Mac. This can help if either your network is down, as you use your smart devices 3/4G connection to connect, or if you are out and about on the road.


Visit the AppStore (Apple) or Play Store (Android) and download the free RD Client app which should look similar to the image on the right.



Upon opening the app for the first time, you will be prompted to setup a connection. You can do this by selecting the '+' found in the top right hand side of the screen



From the connection types select 'Add Remote Resource Feed'






## RD Client for access to Epitaph and AdvantEDGE

The next screen allows you to enter the Feed URL along with your User Name and Password You should enter the details as:



User Name: hosted\username

Password: As normal




Once you have entered these credentails your RD Client will then automatically try and log you on.





## RD Client for access to Epitaph and AdvantEDGE

If you are successful then you should be greeted with your regular folders and module(s).



If your connection was not successful, please check the details entered and try again. To do this please hold your finger on the 'RemoteApps' text until a cog wheel appears. You can then edit the connection details and try again.

To open the folder or module you need to do single tap the revelevant icon.

Once you have finished using the app, you can simply close the app down as you would any normal app from your device.
